I am certain that you are aware that student SAFETY is our first priority. As such, I wanted to ensure that you were aware of an incident that we were made aware of today. This afternoon, we received a report from a student about a possible threat against the Whitehall Jr./Sr. High School that had been sent to a student over April Recess. In cooperation with the New York State Police we immediately investigated and deemed the threat not credible.

We have taken all the necessary steps and procedures to deal with the student who made the non-credible threat. This includes contact with the New York State Police as well as formal disciplinary action at school.

I would like to thank the New York State Police for their immediate response and investigation as well as working with our administrative team to investigate this threat so quickly and thoroughly.

I would also like to thank the students who shared what they heard so this could be addressed. As always, we encourage our community and our students: "If you See Something or if you Hear Something, Say Something!"

Working together, the school and community can help to provide the safest learning environment for our children.
